Description of wine, vineyards, winemaking etc. :

The red NOTIOS (in Greek it means «The Southerner») comes from selected grapes of Agiorgitiko variety, from the hills surrounding Nemea. The yield of the non-irrigated vineyard that we chose does not exceed 80 hl/ha.

The careful wine-making procedure in our small but modern winery, which is situated in the heart of the vineyard, has given us a relatively complex and pleasant red wine with a possibility of an about 36 to 48-month further ageing.

It has a dark red-violet colour, an intense and persistent fruity flavour as well as a particular aromatic finesse. Being relatively sophisticated for its young age, it will «slide» among gooseberry, butter caramel and the discreet fragrance of wood, gifted with a particularly soft flavour with soft tannins that will underline a relatively rich, well structured velvety body.
